Recommendation of Alumnus(a)*

The U.S. Pony Clubs, Inc. is seeking nominations for the USPC Academy of Achievement. Up to eight Pony Club alumni who have been outstanding in their fields after leaving Pony Club will be selected by a national USPC committee for this honor. As they will be participants in the National USPC Youth Congress, those nominated should be articulate and comfortable in large groups. They should enjoy working with young people and be willing to spend two days in small group discussions and activities focusing on young people's development. The outstanding alumni selected for this honor will be inducted into the Academy at USPC's Annual Meeting at an Honors Banquet to be held on Friday, January 25, 2008 in Boston, MA.

Qualifications for nomination are the following:

- Outstanding achievement after leaving Pony Club (any field)
- Strong Pony Club background
- At least a C rating (or C3, if that rating was in existence)
- Over 25 years of age

Please note that we must have enough information about this person to fairly evaluate them as a potential honoree and how they would fit into the program, so please give **complete** information. Anyone (with or without a USPC affiliation) is welcome to nominate a Pony Club alumni.
